Speed Limits:

The posted speed on Hwy 11 from County T to the ball park was discussed. Itemed tabled.

Ald. Peterson made a motion to increase the posted speed limit on 23rd St. from 1st Center Av. to County T to 35 mph from the current 25 mph. Stocks 2nd. Motion carried.

Committee discussed the traffic speed on County F adjacent to the swimming pool during summer months with an eye to encourage traffic to slow down. No action at this time.

Building Inspector:
