

Public Safety Committee Minutes
Wednesday, February 6, 2013 4:30pm

Present: Alderman Vickers, Tim Stocks, Police Chief Tom Moczynski, Alderman Peterson.

Alderman Vickers called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Minutes from the January 14, 2013 meeting were distributed. Peterson made motion to accept, Vickers seconded. Motion to approve minutes carried.

Mr. Higbee discussed his concerns on the proposed truck parking ordinance. Mr. Policastro stated trucks are still using 15th St. to travel to Kuhn Industries, “No Trucks” signs are missing from the street. Committee discussed various alternatives. Signage seems to be most viable method. Chief Mocznski will coordinate with Public Works Director Vogel. Library Director Nikki Busch requested some minor changes to the Farm Market Permit issued last month. An earlier start time for vendors of 7A, and 3-5 more parking spaces for customers on W. 5th Av. in front of library were approved by the committee.

Chief Moczynski distributed final copy of the proposed trucking ordinance that will be presented to the City Council for consideration.

2013 Squad car bids:

Squad car bids returned from several vendors, local and statewide. Following discussion Peterson made motion to accept bid from Brodhead Chevrolet, Vickers second. Motion carried.

Chief Moczynski anticipates March 2013 interviewing for these positions. Vickers and Stocks volunteered to sit on interview panel along with Chief Moczynski.
