REC PROGRAMS: The winter volleyball leagues will be finishing up on March 18th for the Sunday night league and March 21st for the Wednesday night league. Stacie Baldwin is the volleyball supervisor and there are 17 teams. The 2nd & 3rd grade boys and girls basketball program finished up last Wednesday. The third grade met in January and the second grade met in February, for one hour after school to work on the fundamentals of basketball. Our winter Yoga series taught by Lisa Biber, finished up a 7 week program on Monday nights at the High School. Dodgeball for 4th – 6th grades will begin this Wednesday, March 7th and run through April 4th, off on March 28th due to Spring Break. Currently there are 48 kids signed up. Youth Ball Sign-Up is underway; sign-up is from February 15th – March 15th, after the 15th there is a \$20 late fee.

OLD BUSINESS: A future dog park location between East 7th Ave and East 8th Ave. north of 11th St. will be funded strictly on donations and not on tax dollars. A dog park was one of the top priorities that people in the City of Brodhead wanted based on the response given on the Brodhead Comprehensive Plan Survey. At this time, things are moving slowly. Wanting top level fencing might not be an option, still waiting to see on possible funding.

NEW BUSINESS: The new pool heater is supposed to be installed this month by Badger Swimming Pools. Summer application deadline was February 28th. The interviewing process will take place Thursday, March 29th for all first time applicants. Adult ball meetings will be Wednesday, April 4th for the Tuesday and Wednesday night leagues and Wednesday, April 11th for the Church Softball league at City Hall. Advertising sign letters were sent out to all of the previous owners that hung signs on the big diamond at Legion Park in 2017.
