Approval of Previous Minutes:

Police Department:

Deputy Police Chief Raupp advised the Committee that the Digital Radio Project is on schedule and should be completed under the budget.

Deputy Police Chief Raupp advised that Kobussen Bus Company had expressed concerns on getting onto 1st Center Avenue and was requesting Signal Lights. This matter has been addressed several years ago and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation had determined that there was not enough traffic for the State to pay for the Signal Lights and the cost (in excess of \$100,000.00) was too high for the City to pay for.

Deputy Police Chief Raupp advised of a Citizen complaint of no signs in the Downtown area advising of the Winter Parking Ordinance. Deputy Police Chief Raupp will research the matter and bring suggestions back to the Committee.

Deputy Police Chief Raupp advised that at this time there is not a City Ordinance to require House Numbers on all residences and Business's in the City. Deputy Police Chief Raupp is working with the City Attorney on this matter, as it is a Public Safety issue for finding locations in the City.
