

Public Safety Committee Minutes
Wednesday, June 5, 2013 4:30pm

Present: Alderman Vickers, Tim Stocks, Police Chief Tom Moczynski, Phil Rundle, Ald. Steve Peterson

Alderman Vickers called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Minutes from the May 8, 2013 meeting was distributed. Ald. Peterson made motion to accept minutes. Ald. Vickers seconded. Motion carried.

Guests Mary Mason and Dennis Haberman spoke to the results of the drivers meeting regarding the proposed parking of rigs on 11th St. city property. They indicated there are approximately 15-20 drivers in Brodhead with spaces for 8 rigs maximum at the proposed site. The committee requested the drivers provide a list of all potential users of the spaces and whether the drivers preferred a limited lottery for the permits with a guaranteed space, or a first come basis. Mary Mason and Dennis Haberman agreed to provide this information to the committee within a month.

Guest Bob Higbee spoke to the traffic noise in his neighbor at shift changes of Kuhn Manufacturing. He feels the main contributing factor is a four-way stop at 16th St. and W. 7th Av. Mr. Higbee questioned the need for the stop in all directions. Committee will refer item to the City Engineer. Mr. Higbee also spoke to the problem of trucks parked on W. 8th Av. with engines running all night. Chief Moczynski will monitor situation.
