

**Public Safety Committee Minutes**  
**Wednesday July 2, 2014 4:30PM**

Present: Police Chief Tom Moczynski, Phil Rundle, Alderman Troy Nyman, Alderman Tim Stocks

Chairperson Stocks called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Chairperson Stocks read the minutes of the previous meeting. Rundle made motion to accept. Nyman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Minutes approved.

**Guests:** Brianna Deininger who addressed the committee concerning her request for a bartender's license.

**Fire Department:**

No report. Chairperson Stocks noted that the committee hasn't had a representative at the Public Safety Committee meetings since the formation of the Fire District. Ald. Nyman said he would act as a coordinator until more formal arrangements are made.

Speed concerns on 4<sup>th</sup> St. at City swimming Pool:

Chief Moczynski shared info on flashing speed sign selections and costs. "Pool Drop Off Only" paint on drop off area at pool also discussed. Rundle made motion to direct Chief Moczynski to pursue the paint markings with Public Works and gather more info on the requirements for appropriate sized flashing speed sign. Nyman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried.

Hiring CSO's:

Chief Moczynski reported he is continuing the city's procedure for hiring new employees including the dispatcher position, part time officer, and CSOs. Rundle made motion to approve Chief Moczynski's request to post for two CSO positions. Nyman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried. Interview dates were set by the committee for the following: Dispatcher-July 9, 2014 5PM, CSO's-July 15, 2014, 11AM, Officer-August 12, 2014 11AM.

Rundle made a motion to go to Closed Session per Wi Stat Sec. 19.85(1)(c) to consider Employee salaries, wages & benefits. Police Merit Pay. Nyman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Went to Closed Session at 6:21P. Nyman made a motion to return to Open Session. Rundle 2<sup>nd</sup>. Returned to Open Session at 6:38P. Rundle made motion to approve merit pay increases as recommended by Chief Moczynski in closed session. Nyman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried.

### **Building Inspector:**

Chief Moczynski up-dated the committee on zoning enforcement issues the PD has been working on. Alderman Stocks and Phil Rundle voiced concern on costs to the PD and if zoning issues pull the department from its primary mission-public safety. More discussion necessary. No action.
