

**CITY OF BRODHEAD  
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES  
Monday, July 9, 2018**

**Present:** Mayor Pinnow, Aldermen Nyman, Bruce, Anderson, Fox, Peach and Huntington. City Clerk Withee and City Attorney Mark Schroeder.

Mayor Pinnow called meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Roll call shows all Aldermen present.

**Minutes:** Motion by Fox to approve minutes from June 19, 2018. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**Public Safety:** Chief Hughes presented Resolution 2018-020 Waiving Ordinance 290-21 Open Intoxicants for Covered Bridge Days Activities. Better Brodhead has requested that section 3 be deleted in its entirety. Discussion by council. Motion by Peach to approve Resolution 2018-020 with section 3 deleted. Second by Nyman. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented applications for temporary operator licenses for Angallita Streuly, Curtis Streuly and Dan Palan. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Anderson to approve temporary operator licenses as presented. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented applications for operator licenses for Jillian Manley, Jocelyn Manley, Magnolia Grenawalt, Kimberly Love, Meghan Krupke and Miranda Michel. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Anderson to approve operator licenses as presented. Second by Nyman. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented a Public Event Permit for Brodhead Sports Boosters for their Legion Park Softball Tournament starting at 5pm on August 10 and continuing until 8pm on August 12 and Brodhead Chamber of Commerce for the 900 block of Exchange St and the vacant lot at 19<sup>th</sup> and County Rd T, and the parade route. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Fox to approve the applications as presented. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented a Public Event Permit for Memorial Public Library for their Summer Reading Wrap Party on Saturday, July 28<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Fox to approve the applications as presented. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented a Public Event Permit for Brodhead Jaycees for the Kids Fun Run on August 11<sup>th</sup>. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Fox to approve the applications as presented. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented a Public Event Permit for Kaitlyn's Classic Car Show on Saturday, September 1<sup>st</sup> from 4:30 pm to 8:00 pm. Public Safety Committee has recommended approval. Motion by Fox to approve the applications as presented. Second by Peach. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented an application for a Temporary Class B Liquor License for the Brodhead Sports Boosters for Legion Park from August 10<sup>th</sup> to August 12<sup>th</sup> and Brodhead Chamber of Commerce 19<sup>th</sup> St and E 9<sup>th</sup> Ave (city vacant lot) and W Exchange St from August 10<sup>th</sup> to August 12<sup>th</sup> both for Covered Bridge Days. The Public Safety committee recommends approval. Motion by Anderson to approve the applications as presented. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.

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Chief Hughes presented information regarding opening all City Streets to ATV/UTV Traffic. Alderman Peach addressed the council and public. Discussion by council. Chief Hughes asked council to give recommendations and to bring back for a final decision at the second council meeting in July. Motion by Nyman to table. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Hughes presented information regarding temporary no parking in the 2100 block of 1<sup>st</sup> Center Ave due to McDonald's remodeling and Kwik Trip construction. Discussion by council. Motion by Nyman to approve the placing of temporary no parking signs in the area of the construction. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**BID Board & Revitalization:** Mayor Pinnow stated that 205 people attended the Concert in the Park at Veterans Park on Sunday night.

**Historic Preservation:** Alderman Huntington stated they approved a new sign for the Mattress and Furniture Store.

**Plan Commission:** Attorney Schroeder presented an extraterritorial review of preliminary CSM for Hayden. The Plan Commission recommends approval. Discussion by council. Motion by Fox to approve extraterritorial preliminary CSM for Hayden as presented. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

Attorney Schroeder presented a proposal from SBA Towers regarding their cell tower lease with the city. Plan Commission recommends city enter into negotiations with SBA Towers. Discussion by council. Motion by Peach to enter into negotiations with SBA Towers. Second by Anderson. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**Mayor Report:** Future Agendas: ATV/UTV Routes

Mayor Pinnow stated that August 21<sup>st</sup> is UniverCity Kickoff, depot dedication is Saturday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, Highway 104 meeting was held (Hwy 11 to Hwy 92) will be repaired by 2021 or sooner if they have funding.

Clerk Withee stated that due to the election being held on August 14, 2018 council chambers will need to be set up for the election on Monday. Discussion by council. Motion by Anderson to cancel the council meeting on August 13, 2018. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.
