

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, September 3, 2014

Present, Tim Stocks, Phil Rundle, Chief Tom Moczynski, Rich Bennett, Rob Scheidegger and Troy Nyman arrived at 1730 hours.

The meeting was called to order at 1630 hours, by Tim Stocks.

Phil Rundle made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes, Tim Stocks seconded, carried.

Audra Snyder appeared with questions on her recent property issues and citations. Audra Snyder stated that she feels that she is being picked on and requested to know who was complaining about her property. Chief Moczynski advised the name of the complainant. Chief Moczynski also explained the ordinances concerning pools.

Fire Chief Rob Scheidegger requested that 16th Street, between W. 7th Ave and W. 8th Ave be made a "No Parking" on the street as with vehicles being parked on both sides of the street, a Fire Engine would not be able to get through for a Fire Call. Fire Chief Scheidegger stated that it would help if only the North side of 16th Street was "No Parking", but would allow for more clearance for the Fire Department (Emergency) vehicles, if both sides of 16th Street was "No Parking". This will need to be discussed with the Street Department. A motion was made by Tim Stocks to ask for a Temporary no street parking on 16th Street at Monday night (September 8, 2014) City Council meeting. Rich Bennett 2nd the motion, which was carried.

Bartender Licenses were presented by Chief Moczynski:

Ryan Johnson and Hayley Stauffalher, Phil Rundle moved to approve, 2nd by Tim Stocks, carried.

Jessica L. Sandlin did not complete the application, Chief Moczynski stated that he has requested that she complete the application, which has not be done. Tim Stocks moved to deny the application, 2nd by Rich Bennett. Denied.

Dan Palin and Linda Wahl were present for the Chamber, asking that for Autumn Fest (September 27, 2014), that a double fence is not required and that beer would be allowed in the entire Square area (900 block of West Exchange Street). Dan Palin said that they would have a single fence at all entrances to the Square and that they would be selling the beer from approximately 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. After discussion, Phil Rundle moved that this be

approved after review and approval by the City Attorney, that no laws would be violated, 2nd by Tim Stocks, carried.

Phil Rundle moved to close the Square (900 block of W. Exchange Street) from 6:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on September 27, 2014 for Autumn Fest.

Chief Moczynski request that Trick or Treat hours be set for Halloween on October 31, 2014 from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Phil Rundle moved to approve, 2nd by Tim Stocks, carried.

Chief Moczynski presented an update of the Speed Concerns by the City Pool on 4th Street. Chief Moczynski has spoken with Street Supervisor Rich Vogel and Green County Highway Department about the Speed Board and posting it outside of the City entrance on CTH F. Chief Moczynski requested that \$4000.00 be placed into the 2015 budget for the purchase of the Speed Board. Tim Stocks moved to approve, 2nd by Phil Rundle, carried.

Chief Moczynski advised that there is one vacant Full-Time and one vacant Part-time position open in Dispatch. Chief Moczynski requested permission to advertise to fill these positions. Tim Stocks moved to approve, 2nd by Phil Rundle, carried.

Tim Stocks mentioned concerns/questions on Building Permits, Inspections.

At 5:45 p.m. Phil Rundle moved to go into closed session for Personnel matters, 2nd by Tim Stocks, carried.

At 6:40 p.m. Troy Nyman moved to return to open session, 2nd by Phil Rundle, carried.
