

Minutes
Thursday, November 1, 2018
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE (PSC)

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by Chairperson Peach 5 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:**
 - Member Present: Chairperson Richard Peach, Mary Mason, Peter Bernstein, Don Mueller, and Youth in Government Representative Craig Christensen
 - Member Excused: Youth in Government Representative Mya Wilson
 - Also Present: Better Brodhead Kathy Comeau, Tim Stocks, Bob Higbee, and Independent Register Erin Gokey.
 - Chairman Peach welcomed Craig and had him introduce himself and why the interest in this Committee. Chairman Peach asked if Craig is allowed to vote, Chief Hughes stated he could.
3. **Motion to deviate from the order of the agenda if necessary:** Bernstein motioned, Mason 2nd to deviate if necessary, all aye.
4. **Approval of previous meeting minutes:** Peach motioned, Mason 2nd to approve the October minutes as presented, all aye.
5. **Public Appearances:** Higbee sought the status of his complaint regarding the noise being produced by Kuhn, as well as, the removal of the stop signs and the parking issues. Peach requested the Chief have his issue placed on a future Council agenda.
6. **Police Chief's, Fire Chief's and EMS Captain's reports:** Verbal report by Chief Hughes;
 - Chief Hughes highlighted the mass causality table top exercise conducted last night at the High School. Bernstein attended on behalf of PSC. Chief Hughes stated the full scale exercise will be held in spring of 2019.
 - Police K9 Arrow has been certified and is now on patrol.
 - On 10/10 Chief Hughes attended the UW-Madison Alcohol Policy Seminar. Chief Hughes was a member of the planning committee. Chief Hughes explained the purpose of seminar. Chief Hughes also provided the PSC with literature regarding alcohol effects on snowmobiling, ATV, and mental health.
 - On 10/23 the Brodhead Fire Chief, EMS Captain and Chief Hughes held their quarterly meeting to discuss issues of mutual concern.
7. **Old Business**
 - a. **9-1-1 Cost/Benefit Analysis Review:** Chief Hughes advised on 10/05 he met with the UniverCity students conducting the Monroe Police Dispatch study. Chief Hughes will be having a follow up meeting with them on 11/09.
 - b. **Decatur Township request to provide police services:** Chief Hughes provided the PSC with the requested financial information in order to better determine an hourly rate. Peach requested Hughes bring to the December PSC meeting the final draft of the intergovernmental agreement, with this hourly rate inserted, so a final decision can be rendered.
8. **New Business**
 - a. **Operator's Licenses:** Peach motioned, Mueller 2nd, to recommend approval of 15 operator's license; all aye.
 - b. **Public Event Permits:** Peach motioned, Mueller 2nd, to recommend approval of the Chamber's application for its annual Fire and Ice Festival, which includes the parade; all aye.
 - c. **Temporary Class B Licenses:** Peach motioned, Mueller 2nd, to recommend approval of the Chamber's application for the Fire and Ice Festival; all aye.
 - d. **Other City licenses and permits:** Mueller motioned, Mason 2nd, to recommend approval of the Kwik Trip's retail application to sell beer, liquor and tobacco products, with the caveat that all "Liquor and tobacco products shall be kept behind the cashier area and beer products shall be

kept separate from all other non-alcohol related merchandise. Alcohol and tobacco merchandise shall be covered by video surveillance”; all aye.

- Peach reminded Chief Hughes of the need for the Council to approve a resolution allowing open intoxicants on the Square during Fire and Ice.

9. **Committee Comments or Questions:** Peach inquired if discussion was still needed in regard to creating an ordinance which regulates carriage rides and mobile food vendors. Chief Hughes reported after an uptick in inquiries last year there have been no requests made. Thus, he has no objection removing these items.

10. **Future agenda items and next meeting date and time:**
