

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, March 4, 2015

Present: Tim Stocks, Phil Rundle, Deputy Police Chief Brian Raupp, Rich Bennett, Assistant Fire Chief Brian Shearer and Officer Brian Bennett. Troy Nyman absent.

Meeting called to order by Tim Stocks at 16:30 hours.

Approval of Previous Minutes:

Phil Rundle moved and Rich Bennett 2nd to approve the February 4, 2015 meeting minutes.

Fire Department:

Assistant Fire Chief Shearer advised that the Fire District has outsourced the Fire Inspections and that enforcement issues still need clarification. It was suggested that the Brodhead Police Department issue citations if necessary for City violations that are needed. The Fire Inspector would need to give the information to the Police Department for enforcement.

Police Department:
