Motion to accept August minutes by Dick, second by Mary. Motion passed.

Concerned Citizens: Resident in the area of E 3rd Ave & the RR tracks has concern about mess left by RR. Rich will look into.

Discussed the property conflict at the Mill Race spillway with Paul Heins. Rich reported that Paul has the information he wanted from the City and is discussing it with his attorney.

Discussed Dennis Solchenberger's past sewer problems. Rich reported to the committee that Mr. Solchenberger had his lateral televised and the problem was at the repair from the time the phone company put the new line in. It has been repaired.

Rich reported the Railroad Commissioner was sent a letter by the City Attorney. Our next step is a resolution which will be brought before the council for action.

Rich reported that the Landfill can no longer grind brush do to equipment age, so Rich has been working with Monroe to contact private companies and work out the best deal. Rich recommended Atlas Custom Grinding at \$375 an hour.

Rich asked the committee if they had a minimum amount they wanted for the 1997 Ford pick up with plow. Committee asked for a minimum of \$2,000. Rich will put it out for bids this month.

Committee reviewed the budget.

Concerns of committee members – Mary would like to see yield signs on E 6th Avenue at 15th Street. It was suggested she take that to the Public Safety Committee.
