

PARK BOARD MINUTES
07 MAR 16

Chairman – Lewie Schliem, Council Rep – Troy Nyman

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Members present included: Becky Malkow, Troy Gerber, Troy Nyman, Wally Wilson and Wade Boegli. Absent: Missy Kuebli and Lewie Schliem. The previous minutes were read and approved.

VFW – Liquor License – Legion Park: VFW member Joel Steinmann spoke, with Public Safety rep/Police Chief Chris Hughes in attendance. The VFW would like to serve alcohol at Wally Wilson Field on adult league nights. Those nights would be Tuesday and Wednesday; and if there is a Thursday night coed league, they would also serve that night too, along the 1st base side of the adult diamond. Alcohol could be purchased 1 hour before games begin and up to 1 hour after games end, during adult leagues only, which begin in May and end in August, no weekends. The Public Safety and City Council have approved the liquor license and wanted to run it through the Park Board. Troy Nyman made a motion to allow the VFW to serve alcohol at Wally Wilson Field on adult softball league nights. Troy Gerber seconds it and everyone else was in favor.

JANUARY & FEBRUARY ITEMS: Park reservations began the first business day in January. Summer employment applications were available from the first business day of January to February 29th. The 2nd and 3rd grade boys and girls basketball program finished up on February 24th. The 3rd graders practiced four Wednesdays of January and the 2nd graders practiced four Wednesdays of February.

REC PROGRAMS: Dodgeball for 4th – 6th grade boys and girls is underway. The program is four weeks long and meets on Tuesdays at the Middle School from 3:15 – 4:30. There are two weeks left of indoor coed winter volleyball. The Brodhead Youth Ball Sign-up has begun. Parents have until March 31st to sign their child up, before they are charged a late fee. Games and practices will begin in May.

OLD BUSINESS: The driveway at Legion Park is finished. The old deteriorated driveway was replaced with a new blacktop one. A huge improvement!

There won't be any meetings for Dec., Jan., & Feb. meetings. Wade will be officiating those nights. If something important comes up, we will set up a special meeting.

NEW BUSINESS: Seasonal employee interviews will be Thursday, March 24th.

Adult Ball letters have been sent out to all past managers. This year Wade is going to try and see if he can get a Coed League started on Thursday nights to replace the women's league that is no longer.

Park sign participants will be receiving their letter for renewal next week. The parks department charges \$100.00 for advertisers to hang a sign at Wally Wilson Field.

Volleyball letters will be sent out the first week of April to all previous volleyball managers who have participated in both winter and summer leagues. The Thursday night coed league will begin May 5th.

New this year at the Swimming Pool will be a Season Pool Information Pass that will have to be completed by the pass holder. Each family pass will accommodate a family with 2 adults and 4 children living at the same address. It has been a problem in the pass with Family passes where multiple families are added under one pass. This is the same way Monroe does there pool passes.
