

PARK BOARD MINUTES
06 APR 15

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Members present included: Missy Kuebli, Becky Malkow, Troy Nyman, Lewie Schliem, Wally Wilson and Wade Boegli. Absent: Troy Gerber. The previous minutes were read and approved.

2015 SUMMER APPLICANTS: Last Friday, April 3rd, Wade, Aaron Haycraft, Stacie Baldwin and John Bernstein interviewed 12 applicants for the 6 open positions. Wade presented the 2015 summer employees to the park board, everyone was in favor and Wade will take the list to the City Council for final approval.

APRIL REMINDERS: Wade handed out an April Reminder list. This list is a “to-do” list of what needs to be done during the month of April. It helps with staying on top of things in the busy month of April.

REC PROGRAMS: Youth Ball Sign-up is still going on. Teams will be picked at the end of April and Leagues will begin in June. Softball leagues will begin the first week of May. This will be the first year there won't be a women's league. The league was in existence for 19 years. Wade is advertising for a coed league to hopefully replace the women's league. Sand volleyball registration is going on right now. Each team from the past was sent an information letter and games will begin in May.

OLD BUSINESS: Keith Krause of Decatur Lake Mill Race and Dick Benesh representing Pearl Island were in attendance looking for the Brodhead Park & Rec Dept. to go 1/3 in on the addition of 5 new beefed up picnic tables with County Line Sportsman and the DLMR Association; 4 tables would go under the pavilion at the Decatur Dam Park and the other one would go on the west side of the dam. Each organization would come up with an amount of \$1,571.80 for a total of \$4,715.40 and Pearl Island would match that amount. This is a win – win for all parties involved. Wally made a motion and Becky second it, to donate the money towards this project. The Park & Rec. Dept. received a nice thank you from the DLMR.

NEW BUSINESS: Wade is going to look into signage for the Decatur Dam Park and Headgates Park. Currently there is no signage identifying either area.
