

PARK BOARD MINUTES
05 OCT 15

Chairman – Lewie Schliem, Council Rep – Troy Nyman, Secretary – Missy Kuebli

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Members present included: Troy Nyman, Lewie Schliem and Wade Boegli. No quorum. Absent: Missy Kuebli, Becky Malkow, Troy Gerber and Wally Wilson. The previous minutes were read and approved.

BUDGET PROPOSAL: Wade presented the proposed budget for 2016 to the board. There was not an increase over 2015. Capital expenditures were gone over and explained.

FALL REMINDERS: Wade handed out his Fall Reminder list to the board; this is a “to-do” list of what needs to be done during the months of September – November so nothing is forgotten.

REC PROGRAMS: The NFL Flag Football program has 133 kids out. We just completed are 4th week of flag football and have 3 weeks remaining. There are 7 teams in the 2nd & 3rd grade and 12 teams in the 4th – 6th grade. We had a flag football float in the Homecoming parade and will be participating in the halftime activity of the October 16th game.

Pickleball will be moving inside on Wednesday nights beginning in November at the elementary gym. Indoor volleyball sign-up is underway. Leagues are Sunday and Wednesday nights.

OLD BUSINESS: The lifeguard chairs at the pool were replaced with money left from last years’ pool budget.

Outdoor matting was added to the batting cage at Legion Park. This was purchased from the youth ball fundraiser.

New volleyball nets have been installed at Jaycee Park. Last year, the nets had been cut.

Wade expressed the interest of a dog park in the area north of Marigil Park, south of the railroad tracks and exchanging Marigil Park with the City. The Park Board was not in favor.

NEW BUSINESS: Water lines will be installed to all three ball diamonds this fall and will be available beginning next summer. The water lines will be used to water the ball diamonds when we have severe dry weather. The current top dressing requires water to reap the safety benefits. Money that had been raised during the youth ball fundraiser the past two years will pay for this.

Wade will be attending a Certified Pool Operators course November 4th & 5th in Madison. Every 5 years you must get recertified.
