Chief Moczynski distributed update on Proposed Truck Parking Ordinance. Committee reviewed proposal. Chairman Vickers made a motion to submit the proposal as written to the City Council. Seconded by Rundle. Motion carried.

Truck route modifications to accommodate new business on 1st Center at 12th St. was discussed. Motion by Ald Peterson to mark W. 2nd from RR tracks to 12th St. to 1st Center as truck route. Seconded Ald. Vickers. Motion carried. Motion by Ald. Peterson to remove entire 11th St. from truck route designation. Seconded by Rundle. Motion carried. Committee discussed need for additional marking of truck route on 10th St. Referred to Public Works Rich Vogel.

Stop sign placement recommendation from Brad Reents reviewed. Item tabled.

Safe Communities Grant information was discussed. No action taken.
