Speed limit change Hwy 11:

Committee discussed request to consider change of speed limit on Hwy 11 from Cty "T" to ball park from 25MPH to 35MPH. Motion by Vickers to keep speed limit at 25MPH. Second by Stocks. Motion carried.

Speed limit change 23rd St.:

Committee discussed request to consider change of speed limit on 23rd St. E. 3rd Av. to Cty. "T" from 25MPH to 35MPH. Item tabled until April meeting.

Stop signs at frontage road at 25th St.:

Discussion on placing stop signs on the frontage rd. on the east side of 1st Center and 25th St. Motion was made to recommend to City Council the placement of signs by Rundle. Second by Stocks. Motion carried.

Speed bumps on W. 4th St. at city swimming pool:

Traffic calming measures and possible funding assistance was discussed. Item tabled for more info. Stocks to research and present at April meeting.
