

CITY OF BRODHEAD COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
Tuesday, January 22, 2019

Present: Mayor Pinnow, Alderman Nyman, Bruce, Anderson and Fox. City Clerk Withee and City Attorney Mark Schroeder.

Mayor Pinnow called meeting to order at 5:10 PM. Roll call vote shows all Aldermen present except Peach and Huntington.

Senior/Community Center: Attorney Schroeder stated that he had not heard from the state regarding the referendum question. At the January 14th meeting council approved a referendum question relating to senior/community center and submitted it to MSA, they then forwarded it on to the DOA. The City and MSA have not received a response from the DOA regarding the referendum question. Clerk Withee is required to submit the referendum question to the county no later than tomorrow. As a precautionary measure the meeting was scheduled for today at 5pm in case we heard from the DOA to allow time to address any issues before tomorrow's deadline.

Attorney Schroeder stated that late this afternoon he was informed by MSA that they were contacted by DOA and they didn't raise an objection to the current referendum question. There is no requirement that council take any action at this time. Discussion by council. Mayor Pinnow stated that we posted the meeting to make sure we met the deadline to submit to the county. Attorney Schroeder stated that the only thing that it doesn't cover is if the portion of the senior center doesn't come up to 1.4 million.

Adjournment: Motion to adjourn by Fox. Second by Anderson. Four ayes. Adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
