

**CITY OF BRODHEAD COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES  
THURSDAY, July 30, 2015**

**Present:** Mayor Pinnow, Alderman Nyman, Hale, Anderson, Bernstein, Rosheisen and Fox. City Clerk Withee and City Attorney Jamie Olson.

Mayor Pinnow called meeting to order at 5 PM. Roll call vote shows all Aldermen present.

**Public Works:** Gary Gunderson from MSA presented information regarding an opportunity for the city to receive grant funding of 30% to update the lift stations. He stated that timing is key because applications and required paperwork must be submitted by the end of September. Several questions were answered from the council by Greg Gunderson and Rory Strehlow, Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator. Motion by Bernstein to approve the design and funding application for the lift station improvements. Second by Rosheisen. Six ayes. Motion carried

**Public Safety:** Chief Hughes presented a public event application for the Chamber of Commerce for the Covered Bridge Days Street Dance and a Temporary Class B Retailer License for Michele Benesh. Motion by Bernstein to approve the applications as presented. Second by Fox. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**Emergency Management:** Attorney Olson presented a Resolution Authorizing Certain Use of All-Terrain Vehicles and Utility-Terrain Vehicles (ATV's and UTV's) during the Covered Bridge Days Event 2015. City Attorney Olson explained the need for this resolution. Motion by Fox to approve the resolution as presented. Second by Rosheisen. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**Mayor's Report:** Future agendas: nothing at this time

Mayor recommends the appointment of Tammy Slocum to Plan Commission. Motion by Bernstein. Seconded by Nyman. Six ayes. Motion carried.

**Attorney Report:** Attorney Olson presented a Resolution Regarding Handicapped Parking on East Exchange Street near Bank of Brodhead. Rory Strehlow stated the Bank of Brodhead made some improvements recently and would like the handicapped stall closer to the handicapped accessible entrance. Motion by Anderson. Second by Hale. Six ayes. Motion carried.
