Special Meeting: Dispatch Cost/Benefit Analysis Review

- 1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by Chairperson Peach 5 p.m.

- 3. Brodhead 9-1-1 cost/benefit analysis review:
 - Alder Peach opened by stating what he would like to accomplish during this meeting.
 - Alder Peach opened the floor to any public comments.
 - Tim Stocks asked about the feasibility of contracting with Rock County 9-1-1 Communications Center, and if the PSC could use the standards set forth by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA), in their Public Safety Communications Accreditation Program, and if the PSC was going put the issue of maintaining a dispatch to referendum.
 - Chief Hughes handed out a copy of Alder Peach's letter to the Common Council on the PSC progress thus far and his perspectives in regard to moving forward with this review.
 - Discussion on City of Monroe's UniverCity study on consolidating services with Green County Sheriff's office.

 - Brodhead Fire District Calls for Service breakdown, including Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS)
 - o Brodhead Area EMS Calls for Service breakdown
 - Discussion evaluating customer satisfaction.
 - Discussion held on some of the intrinsic value for keeping dispatch in-house.
