

BRODHEAD PARK BOARD MINUTES
TUESDAY, 05 SEPT 17

Call to order at 5:30 pm - Present: Becky Malkow, Paul Huffman, Wally Wilson and Wade Boegli.
Absent: Missy Kuebli.

A motion to accept previous minutes: Motion by Wally, second by Becky. Motion passed.

Committee comments or questions: Becky mentioned the interest from people requesting a Dog Park. Wade had just spoken to Rich Vogel and Jeff Peterson a couple weeks ago to see what land is available. The land north of Marigil Park was all that was available and Aaron Haycraft expressed interest with heading this project. We will look into making this a community project.

POOL HEATER: Wade explained the situation regarding the pool heater. The pool heater broke down in June and after several trips by Zion to fix it, they were not able to get it functioning to its full capacity. A new pool heater is needed for next year. Wade has met with the Brodhead Foundation and will work with Teresa the City Clerk and see what funds are available to put towards a new one. In the meantime, Wade is in contact with Zion to have the current bill reduced from \$9,200 for a pool heater that still doesn't work.

REC PROGRAMS: Adult Ball leagues just finished up. The NFL Flag Football program has 121 participants. The program will begin September 9th and run 7 weeks. Winter volleyball league sign up will be underway. Wade was unsure of the number of teams or if there would be enough for a league. Wade will contact Lisa Biber, a Yoga Instructor, and see if she would be interested in doing a program thru the Park & Rec. and contact Kelly Arn and see if she would have an interest also.

OLD BUSINESS: There was a Lifeguarding class at the pool July 31st – August 3rd, 4 people took the class, taught by Dave Gissing and Stacie Baldwin; current lifeguards were also recertified.

NEW BUSINESS: Jacob Staffon for an Eagle Project, counter sunk railroad ties around every park sign in all the parks. His dedication and hardwork have made these areas around the signs look GREAT! Wade and some of his pool staff repainted park swing sets at Jaycee Park.
