- 1) Alderperson Huntington called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

- 2) Mayor Pinnow thanked all the Citizens in attendance for coming to this meeting. He commented that this was the most citizens who have attended our meetings. He further informed those in attendance that all our meetings are posted and are public (excluding any closed sessions on the agenda).

He also informed the attendees that there will be a referendum in the spring on the cost of the Senior/Community Center.
