Classes hoping to begin on November 13th and run through December 18th.

Putnam Park restrooms had concrete laid down in front of them leading to the basketball courts, prior to that cow mats got us through the busy summer season. Wade got 3 bids for the removal of 5 trees to be taken from Putnam and Veteran's Park. Hail Tree Service came in with the lowest bid at \$2450.00. Wade handed out a Fall reminder list that is used for a guide to make sure everything gets finished before winter approaches.
